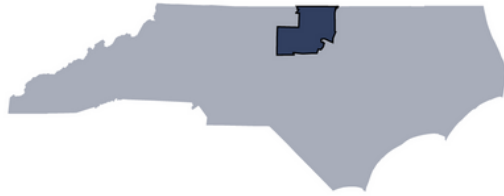


# Duke in the 4th District
